

Committee Member Code of Conduct Appendix 9

As a member of the Committee, I will:

- Listen carefully to my fellow committee members;
- Carefully consider and respect the opinions of my fellow committee members;
- Respect and support all majority decisions of the committee;
- Recognise the authority vested in the committee;
- Keep well-informed of developments relevant to issues that may come from the committee;
- Participate actively in committee meetings and actions and not discuss elsewhere what I am unwilling to discuss in committee meetings;
- Bring to the attention of the committee any issues I believe will have a significant effect on the Association or those we serve:
- Attempt to communicate the needs of those we serve to the committee
- Refer complaints directly to the proper level;
- Recognise my job is to ensure that the Association is well-managed;
- Represent all those whom the Association serves;
- Consider myself a "trustee" of the Association and do my best to ensure it is well-maintained, financially secure and always operating in accordance with our stated objectives;
- Acknowledge conflicts of interest between my personal life, my Club and my position on the committee and abstain from voting or attempting to influence issues in which I am conflicted.
- · Keep confidential information confidential;
- Approach all committee issues with an open mind;
- Be prepared to make the best decision for the Association;
- Do nothing to violate the trust of those who elected me to the committee or of those we serve;
- Focus my efforts on the mission of the Association and not on my personal goals;
- Never exercise authority as a committee member except when acting in a meeting with the full committee or as I am delegated by the committee; and
- Plan to attend every meeting, recognising that my presence is critical to the committee's efficient and effective functioning.

As a member of the Committee, I will not:

- Criticise fellow committee members or their opinions outside of the committee room;
- Use the Association or my position for my personal advantage or that of my friends, relatives or associates;
- Discuss the confidential proceedings of the committee outside the committee room;
- Promise how I will vote on an issue before hearing the discussion and becoming fully informed on that issue;
- Speak for or on behalf of the Association unless I have been specifically authorised to do so.
